

Many children spend their long school days in crowded, dark classrooms built on very low budgets. We have succumbed to thinking that this is the new normal. Changes to school design can be made, as was the case in Italy after the Second World War through the Reggio Emilia Approach; an educational philosophy based on the natural development of children and the importance of the close relationship they share with their environment.

This approach supports our belief that our built environment can assist educational institutions to be healthier, more dynamic and can make students and teachers happier by designing in a way that connects them to nature.

The Virtrium exhibit reveals, in a virtual manner, how an interior windowless space connects the user to the external natural world, digitally capturing real time changes in weather, lighting and sounds and reflecting them internally within the building for the students to experience. This project presents innovations as to how the boundary between the natural environment and built form need not be as definite as previously believed and emphasizes the importance of capturing our natural environment.
